## Scholarship Information

Please read qualifying materials carefully to make sure ALL criteria is met.

Pay close attention to deadlines - some are FAST approaching!

You will be asked to provide the following:

An acceptance letter from a post-secondary institution

ACT score report, when applicable

CACC Supplemental Financial Statement for some scholarships

FAFSA application **MUST** be filed by March 1, 2012. *You and your parents can complete the application @ [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)*

**KCC GOLD KEY: Deadline: January 27, 2012**

This scholarship is for current high school seniors who are planning to attend KCC full time next school year. The required GPA is **3.2** with an ACT score of **20 or higher**. The scholarship provides **\$2,500 annually for two years**, with an **additional \$1,000** for continued education after completion of a two-year degree. Awards will be made to freshmen showing superior academic promise and leadership potential. *Financial need is not a criterion.*

**KELLOGG COMPANY CAREERS: Deadline: January 27, 2012**

This scholarship is awarded to students working toward an Associate Degree in **Accounting, Business Management, or Human Resources Management**. The required GPA is **2.5**. Up to **\$3,000** is rewarded annually for two years while attending KCC including a **paid internship** at the Kellogg Company World Headquarters.

**KCC Foundation Scholarships: Deadline: March 2, 2012**

This scholarship requires at least a 2.5 GPA, 3 letters or recommendation, transcript, 150-word essay, and resume. If a student's GPA is not a 2.5, an instructor or academic advisor can provide a recommendation with the application.

**McCurdy Memorial Foundation and Scofield Trust: Deadline: March 1, 2012**

This scholarship requires initiative and effort demonstrated through leadership, citizenship, work ethic, community service, and financial need. Chosen applicants will be awarded **\$1,500 per year** for McCurdy and **\$700 per year** for Scofield. Scholarship is **renewable for 3 additional years**, providing terms and conditions are met.

**Winship Memorial Scholarship: Deadline: March 15, 2012**

Available to students graduating (graudated) from Battle Creek Publis Schools, or schools in the City of Battle Creek. Scholarships awarded are based on the following criteria: scholastic achievement, character and financial need. Scholarships range from **\$1,000-\$2,100 per student per academic year**. Interested students should complete an application form and obtain transcripts and ACT scores.

**KCC Trustee Scholarships: Deadline: March 28, 2012**

Students interested in this scholarship must be nominated by high school administrative and/or counseling departments. **See your counselor if you would like to be nominated**. One senior from each area high school will be nominated. If nominated, students must fill out an application and demonstrate leadership experience, community service involvement, and school involvement.

Blanche Barr Trone Scholarship Trust: **Deadline:**

Although the Trust is not limited, the Trustee is particularly interested in students who are or will pursue a **career in pharmacy**. The trustee will also consider applications in all fields of study from **needy and deserving students**.

Calhoun Area Career Center Scholarships: **Deadline: March 16, 2012**

*Please see your instructor or counselor for an application.*

**Non-Traditional Careers Scholarship** (Supplemental Financial Form needed): Awarded to students showing academic promise, leadership potential, and a commitment to pursue training in a non-traditional field.

**Jack Korff Scholarship:** A **\$1,000 scholarship** is available for 1 deserving student in each of the center's 17 programs who demonstrates potential for future success at a post-secondary college, technical institute, or university. Student should show academic promise, good attendance, and a commitment to pursue training/education.

**Superintendent's Scholarship** (Supplemental Financial Form needed): Selection is based on GPA, leadership, extra-curricular activities and potential for success. **Up to seven (7) \$1,000 scholarships** will be awarded to graduating students who plan to further their education or training in areas related to their CACC program.
