

Fluency Strategy

Strategy: Pre-read to Reread. This strategy can be used when a student needs to work on becoming more fluent.

Appropriate Grade Level: K-5

Materials Needed:

- Reading selection at the student's instructional level.

Procedures/Steps:

1. First read the selection aloud for the student, this in pre-reading.
2. Have the students read the selection back to you twice. The second time is called a "warm" read.
3. Do a vocabulary check.
4. Review any words the student stumbled on.
5. Ask the student 3 comprehension questions.
6. Have the student read the selection again. This is called the "hot" read or reread.

Comments/Tips:

- This can be done at all grade levels.
