School Counselor Mentor

(Formerly offered under New Teacher Mentor)

(A maximum of 9.0 SB-CEUs earned in a five-year period can be used toward certificate renewal.)

With the successful completion of this activity, 3.0 SB-CEUs will be awarded.

Criteria for Eligibility

- Mentoring a new School Guidance Counselor for a full semester of an academic year.
- A School Counselor Mentor must submit an evaluation of the mentoring process for the application period to the building principal.
- **The mentor counselor must submit to the SB-CEU coordinator at the conclusion of the activity:**
 1. a log of mentoring activities during the semester assignment,
 2. the verification form signed by the building principal as confirmation of the successful completion of the assignment.
