**Supervision of School Psychologist Required Practicum/Internship**

*(A maximum of 9.0 SB-CEUs earned in a five-year period can be used toward certificate renewal.)*

**With the successful completion of this activity, 3.0 SB-CEUs will be awarded.**

**Criteria for Eligibility**

- Supervising a preliminary school psychologist certificate holder for not less than 8 weeks.
- A supervising psychologist must provide documentation of being assigned to serve as a supervising school psychologist to the building principal along with an evaluation of the supervision process for the application period.
- **The supervising psychologist must submit to the SB-CEU coordinator at the conclusion of the activity:**
  1. a log of activities during the semester assignment,
  2. the verification form signed by the supervisor or building principal as confirmation of successful completion of the assignment.
  3. a copy of the letter that the supervising psychologist received from the college/ university stating the activity was satisfactorily completed.
