

Minimum - 8 week placement period

Supervision of Student Teacher/Teacher Intern

(A maximum of 9.0 SB-CEUs earned in a five-year period can be used toward certificate renewal.)

With the successful completion of this activity, 3.0 SB-CEUs will be awarded.

Criteria for Eligibility

- A supervising teacher must prepare and submit an evaluation of the student teacher/teacher intern’s performance to the building principal and/or the teacher preparation institution’s representative.
- **The supervising teacher must submit to the SB-CEU coordinator at the conclusion of the activity:**
 1. a log of activities during the 8 week placement assignment,
 2. the verification form signed by the building principal as confirmation of the successful completion of the assignment,
 3. a copy of the letter that the supervising teacher received from the college/ university stating the activity was satisfactorily completed.
