Bill No.	Description and Sponsor	Status & Notes	Committee Date
SB 592	(Kuipers) Allow districts to acquire energy from a cooperative.	On Senate Floor	
SB 636-639 Tie-Bar	(Kuipers/Cassis) Authorizes the establishment of “neighborhood schools” run by parents/teachers/others for any school building in the state.	Passed Senate Education	
SB 698	(Kuipers) Changes algebra II requirement to allow student to take a career/tech course with embedded math content. Allows district to allocate 1.5 credits for 1.5 years of algebra class.	Passed Senate	
SB 739 & 740 Tie-Bar	(Hunter) Provides health insurance coverage for autism treatments.	Sent to Health Policy	
SB 751 – 756 Tie-Bar	(multiple) School board elections may only be held in General November, even year August or in some instances odd year November beginning in 2010.	Sent to Senate Education	
SB 757	(Kahn) Allows all high school requirements to be embedded in career tech, industrial tech or applied arts courses.	Sent to Senate Education
