

**CAMPUS VISITS AND TOURS** — Although not a requirement for admission, prospective students (and their families) are encouraged to visit Olivet college.

Campus visits include a tour and arrangements can be made to include such activities as sitting in on a class, lunch or dinner in the student dining hall, meeting with faculty members, and speaking with admissions and financial aid representatives. It is important that you inform us of the activities you would like to include during your visit.

**SCHEDULING A CAMPUS VISIT** — You can schedule a campus visit by calling the admissions office at 1-800-456-7189 or (269) 749-7635.

The admission office is open for calls and visits Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (May–August); Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (September–April).

**FROM DETROIT (South)** — Take I-94 west to I-69 north. Follow to exit 48 (the first Olivet exit); from the exit ramp – turn right. Proceed about one mile. Turn left at the stop sign (Main Street) and follow to the heart of campus (about 1/2 mile).

**FROM DETROIT (North)** — Take I-696 west to I-96 west to I-69 south to exit 51 (Ainger Road). From the exit ramp – turn left. Proceed about one mile. Turn right at the stop sign (Main Street) and follow to the heart of campus (about 1/2 mile).

**FROM LANSING** — Take I-69 south to exit 51 (Ainger Road). From the exit ramp – turn left. Proceed about one mile. Turn right at the stop sign (Main Street) and follow to the heart of campus (about 1/2 mile).

**FROM CHICAGO/KALAMAZOO** — Take I-94 east to I-69 north. Follow to exit 48 (the first Olivet exit), from the exit ramp – turn right. Proceed about one mile. Turn left at the stop sign (Main Street) and follow to the heart of campus (about 1/2 mile).

**FROM MOUNT PLEASANT** — Take 127 south to I-69 west/south to exit 51 (Ainger Road). From the exit ramp – turn left. Proceed about one mile. Turn right at the stop sign (Main Street) and follow to the heart of campus.

**FROM ANGOLA/FT. WAYNE, IND.** — Take I-69 north to exit 48 (the first Olivet exit), from the exit ramp — turn right. Proceed about one mile. Turn left at the stop sign (Main Street) and follow to the heart of campus (about 1/2 mile).

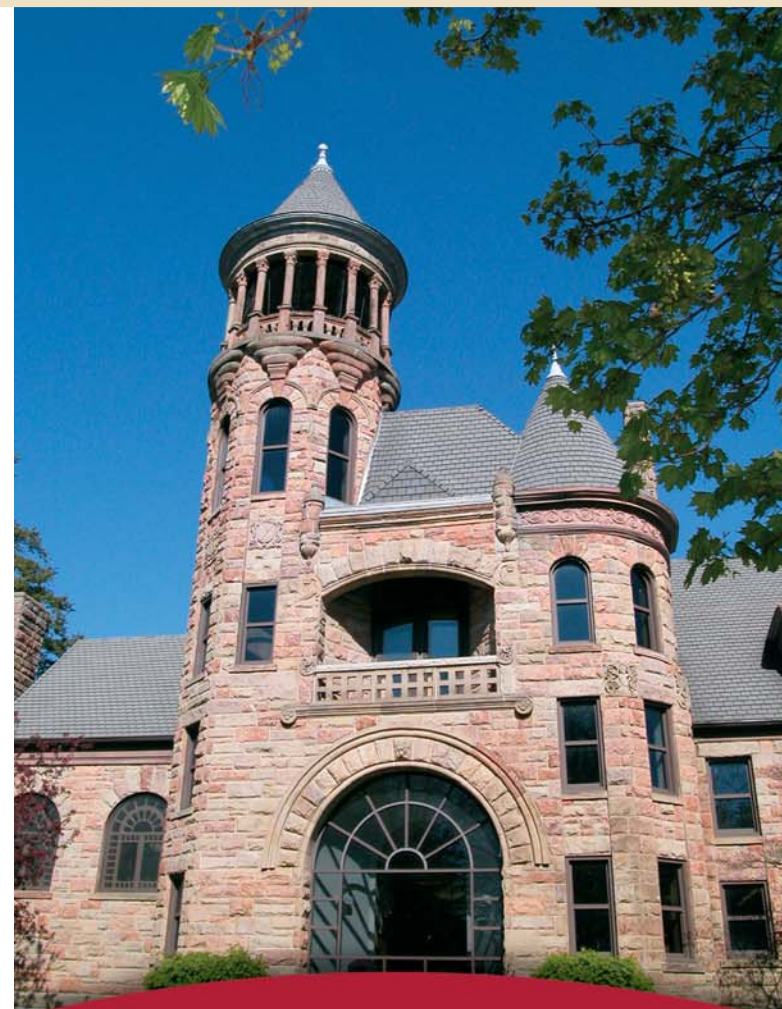

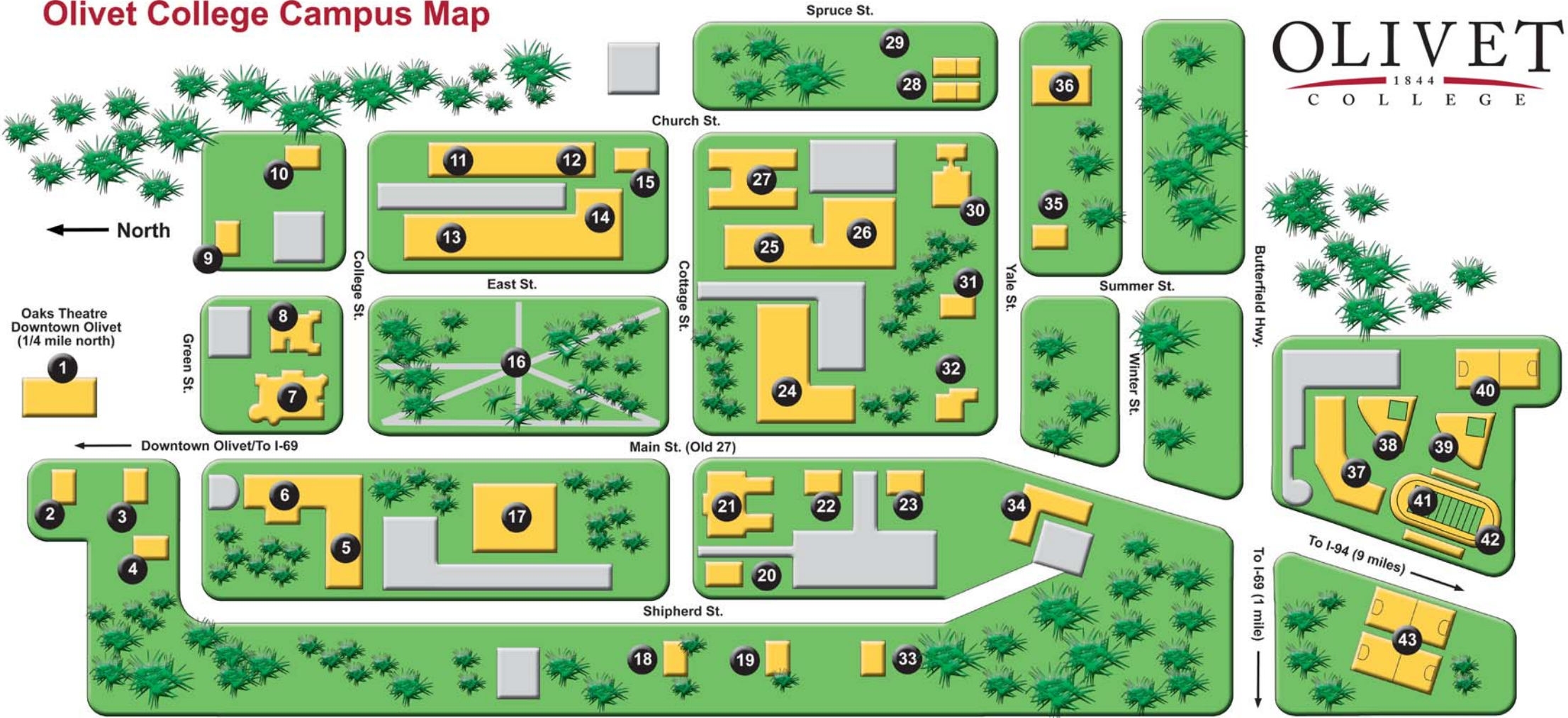
